Business Arising:

Update on Graincorp project (Trish Fraser): There have been holdups, at this stage it's not known whether the project will go ahead. Grant suggested that the project will likely end up too large for the WDDA to manage.

Community Safety Grant

Landscaping

Fuel

The permit application is still in at the shire; notices have gone to all affected residents, process should be complete by the time of the next meeting.

Vicroads has required that we move the driveway 20m along the street so traffic doesn't drive straight across the intersection.

Tender

Tender applications read and passed around; Trish F moved that the tender be awarded to the highest bidder. Seconded Mark K; carried unanimously. Trish to write to all tenderers.

Other items

Les K has supplied a mouse excluder for the shop

Monica has offered 2 planter boxes and the large iron art from the Hopetoun Bon Bon café to come over to the Woomelang Store.

Traveller's Rest opening 11am 28/7; to be advertised, letterboxed and so on closer to the date.

Gwenyth reported that the VicTrack works to renovate the Railway Station have begun.

Jason Collins has received a call from a group of travellers; 15 vans doing the silo art trail, some time in October. Noted that we need to put firewood out, use the footy sheds if needed.

Joe will begin advertising the Colour Run.

The Dump Point is now working - Trish to put on website.

We need to plan more signs around town.
