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I Business:

Joe Collins chaired the meeting.

No business arising from previous meeting.

Joe tabled an email from Marianne Ferguson with updates on current projects:

- Melbourne-based street artist Andrew Bourke (sirium1) to do a mural on the side wall of shop facing the shelter/car-park area at 69-75 Brook St. We would invite him here and organise a caravan for accommodation at the Lions Caravan Park, show Andrew around so he can come up with a design that suits Woomelang.
 - Approx \$5000 cost (all inclusive)
 - vote taken to go ahead: moved Joe Collins, 2nd Shane Michael, carried unanimously.
 - Joe C will work with Marianne on this.
- 69-75 Brook Street:
 - Chris Burns is working on the new driveway entrance
 - Building permit application for the shelter currently being drafted
 - Land Capability Study for the amenities being drafted
 - 1st sculpture for the landscaping has been purchased from Phil Rigg (Grass Tree)
 - Anticipated: car park construction mid September
 - Anticipated: amenities installation 1st week October
 - Anticipated: shelter installation 1st week November.

Signs for the amenities at the Caravan Park and Cronomby Tanks have been delayed - the sign maker's email has been down for a couple of weeks. Signs are expected in 2 weeks.

Furniture for the shelter: Joe C will approach Tyrell College for a quote, and ask Marianne F to approach Hopetoun Men's Shed. Anticipate 4 table/seat items needed with seating for 3 per side.

Working bee: Suction line and drippers are in place at the Tanks, still to be trenched in. Pipe from drain to the site of the toilet block at 69-75 Brook St is trenched in.

Fuel: Travis distributed a new site plan showing Sunraysia Fuel's preferred siting for the bowsers etc. Vote to go ahead on this basis: moved Trish F, second Mark K, carried unanimously. See the Minutes page on the website for a look at the plan.

Woomelang.com - Trish F asked for all members to make sure their organisation or business name is up to date, and to send her any new info to update.

New working bee: Travis M and Shane M to contact Grant K re the pump, needed to be sorted before further work.

Tough as Iron: the meeting discussed all the ideas put forward at the session with Phil Rigg. Four initial subjects were chosen:

- New and old header/tractor
- Cronomby tanks and steam train/railway
- New shop/old shop
- Paddock.

Brydie will collect photos and visit Phil R to arrange for the designs. Trish F will email the list of four subjects to Brydie.

Signage advertising Cronomby Tanks: Shane M raised the question of whether current signage is enough to attract passing traffic to the Tanks. The meeting agreed that more signage is needed on the highway, at a sufficient distance to let people know it's there and stop. Tabled for further discussion.
