Handy Tips & Suggestions for exhibitors:

- Choose oranges or lemons of similar size and shape, retain stem of approx 2cm to demonstrate they are homegrown and freshly picked, these can be washed in warm soapy water to remove any marks.
- Eggs should be clean, polished but not washed.
- Ensure slices are presented cut to the size specified by the schedule.
- Photographs should not be mounted.
- All loose thread to be removed from craft items

Note to Exhibitors:

The Hall will be open from 5pm until 7.30pm on Tuesday the 17th and Wednesday the 18th of October for the purpose of taking entries prior to Show day.

Exhibitors are encouraged to enter as many of their exhibits, as possible, prior to the day.

There is an Aggregate Prize (Open and Children's sections), taken from all sections of the schedule, for most points won.

There is no entry fee for any section of the Flower Show schedule.

Entries close at 9.30am SHARP on the day of the Flower Show, unless otherwise stated in the Schedule. Please note closing entry times for Photography, Painting, Children's sections, Craft, Please check schedule carefully for entry closing times and dates.

The Hall Doors close for judging promptly at 10am on the day.

All exhibitors are asked to read the schedule carefully.

Please attach entry tickets to clean vases/glass containers with tape or rubber bands.

Exhibits are not to be removed from the hall prior to 5pm, for viewing by general public.

Stewards and Judges only, are permitted in the Hall during judging on the day.

All care is taken with your items once they are entered in the Flower Show, however the committee can not take responsibility for damaged or stolen items.
