Business Arising:

Fuel

Trish is following up on legal and insurance enquiries in re the draft contract. WFI have declined to quote, so MGA in Mildura are being approached. Contact has been made with pro bono legal advisers, Trish will report back as soon as there is more information.

Trish is working on 3 applications: the Share Grant for the extension of the garden at Combine

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Corner, the Look Over the Farm Gate grant for events, and an EOI to MP Ann Webster for the Solar Communities Grant. These should all be completed and submitted by Friday April 5th (the deadline for the Share Grant).

General Business

Signs for either end of town

Brydie is working with Mez from the Shire, to renew the town signs, since they look a bit weather-beaten. The slogan "A Land Worth Saving" will be replaced with a fuel sign and the words "Rest Stop"; the top part will have a new picture of either Cronomby Tanks or the Shearing Shed.

Treasurer's Report

Balances: General a/c \$3228.06; Store a/c \$2691.72; Fuel a/c \$1031.31

Kim notes that we no longer need the fuel account as a separate account, and it's just one more set of \$10/month fees coming out. She asked whether she should close that account and transfer the funds to the General account.

Trish moved that the Fuel account be closed; seconded Mark Keenan; carried.
