Business Arising:

1. Shearing Shed grant acquittal – Trish has not yet done, she will work with Rick this week to complete.

2. Fuel contract – Trish will follow up with the pro bono lawyer, who has not yet called back, probably due to the Easter break.

Gwenyth moved that if the lawyer gives us new wording, Trish will circulate via email, and if approved we can send it off to Sunraysia Petroleum before the next meeting. Seonded Trish.

3. List of two people for town working bee: Rick nominated Steve H., no others have any so far. To continue collecting for next meeting.

4. Landcare: Maree Barbary is back, Monica will ask her to contact Trish. There is money set aside for the pump to the solar panels; Rick asked the meeting if we could get the pump from Brad Petschel. Possibly have him install it, the cost should be \$1000 or less. Gwenyth moved that we go ahead on that basis, seconded Manfred, carried.

5. Look Over the Farm Gate grant – the application has been successful, with the dinner to be held around May 21st. Trish moved that the WDDA pay Monica for the dinner, and the grant funds be then paid to the WDDA. Seconded Gwenyth, carried. Trish has send the documents to Rick by email, and will begin organising and publicising this week.

6. Fuel account has been closed, and Brydie spoke to the CBA people at Hopetoun. All fees

General Business:

Dennis Harding has offered to attach new chains to the bollards in the Combine Corner carpark, once we have them.

Monica reported that the Combine Corner toilet went bung before Easter, Brad Petschel had it fixed within 24 hours; Macklins did a pump-out on the septic, so the facilities were working for Easter.

Mon reported that she will be doing the catering for the Boxall auction on May 19th, with around 500 expected; she will divide the profits with some coming to the WDDA for the Store.

Mon reports that the Good Friday Appeal has netted over \$4000 for the year (final figures will be publicised by Trish Stronell), a very strong showing for our tiny town.

Gwenyth notes the times and places for Anzac Day activities:

Anzac Ceremony at the Hall, beginning 9am;

Morning Tea afterwards at the Historical Society (Old Fire Station, Proctor Street), with CWA providing the biscuits.

Historical Society will then stay open for people to see some of the exhibits.

Gwenyth noted that the Historical Society's only source of funds is the Op Shop.
